ITEMS WE NEED *All items must be in new or like-new condition.*

Furniture

- Beds – mattresses, box springs, frames
 - Twin, double/full, queen (no king)
 - Bunk beds
- Dressers (no taller/longer than 6 feet)
- Sofas (6 feet or shorter)
- Futons & Sofa-beds
- Kitchen tables and chairs
- Coffee tables
- TV Stands
- Small Desks (around 3.5 ft x 2 ft)
- Office chairs

Kitchen & Household Appliances

- Washing machines and dryers (as needed)
- Small and mini refrigerators
- Microwaves, toasters, coffee makers
- Slow cookers/crock pots
- Dishware, pots & pans, utensils
- Vacuums, fans, cleaning supplies

Electronics

- Televisions (depending on size and condition)
- DVD Players
- Converter boxes for televisions
- Clocks/clock radios
- Computers & laptops (less than 3 years old)
- Printers, copiers, scanners, projectors
- Digital cameras and camcorders

Note: Shelter Network can only accept appliances and electronics that are up-to-date and in good working condition. Please do not donate items that are broken, outdated, or incompatible with current technology.
