## ITEMS WE NEED – specifically for **Maple Street** and the **Vendome Hotel**, our single adult shelters

### All Toiletries and Feminine Hygiene Products

#### Kitchen Items

- can-openers
- paper plates, bowls, cups, plastic utensils
- paper towels, napkins
- aluminum foil, plastic wrap
- coffee makers, microwaves

#### Cleaning Supplies

#### Office Supplies

- copy paper – white and colored
- envelopes, labels, binder tab dividers
- file folders, pens
- writing pads, scotch tape & dispensers

#### Clothing – must be clean and folded

(We simply don't have the resources, volunteers, or staff available to accept items if they aren't ready to use.)

- business-attire for men and women
- large-size men's clothing
- NEW underwear and socks
- Flip flops / shower shoes

#### Household Items

- twin-sized sheets, pillows, blankets
- plastic mattress covers (twin size)
- towels and washcloths
- lamps, small TVs, alarm clocks (working only)
- flashlights, batteries (AAA, AA, 9V)
- reading glasses

## ITEMS WE CANNOT ACCEPT

Our free services are possible because of the community's generous in-kind donations and financial support. Because we have limited storage space, and in order to minimize disposal costs and overhead, we can only accept items our residents can use immediately in the shelter or in their small apartments once they move out. Regrettably, we cannot accept:

Dirty/stained, torn, broken items  
Expired Carseats, Cribs, Strollers  
Desktop computers (over 3 yrs old)

Any item in need of repair  
Knick-knacks  
Carpeting

Candles  
Wine glasses or any alcohol-related items

We can only accept **furniture donations if they can be immediately used in our facilities**. We do pick-ups of furniture items from locations in San Mateo County about once a month. Thank you for understanding our limited resources and storage space.
